STATEMENT OF GENERAL INTENT:

The Village of Dunnottar has initiated a Trap, Neuter and Release (TNR) Program to control the feral cat population.

The purpose of this policy is to establish a procedure for residents to transport a feral cat to a designated veterinary clinic for surgery and for the municipality to be responsible for the veterinary costs.

POLICY GUIDELINES:

- 1. Only residents of the Village of Dunnottar are eligible to participate in this program.
- 2. Residents must provide their name and civic address.
- 3. The description of the feral cat must be disclosed as well as the location it habitually occupies.
- 4. Those residents accepted for the program will receive a document (attached as Schedule A) for submission to the approved veterinarian.
- 5. Residents participating in this program will be responsible for the trapping and transporting of the feral cat. The Village of Dunnottar will cover only the necessary veterinary expenses.
